

Job Title:	Articulated (Off-Road) Truck Driver
Reports to:	Superintendent or Foreman
Classification:	Non-Exempt
Duration:	Length of project or full-time

Job Purpose

The primary purpose of this position is to run articulated in various terrains and conditions in order to help achieve construction goals in a timely manner.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Maintain an accurate log book and load count;
- Have a basic understanding of in-cab technology;
- Ability to understand simple or complex traffic management plans;
- Exercise good judgment and clear communication skills when communicating with surrounding equipment operators, truck drivers and laborers;
- Understanding of the use of spotters for backing and dumping activities;
- Recognize mechanical errors and report them to the superintendent and field mechanic;
- Safely execute all job responsibilities;
- Follow all job site safety rules and wear proper PPE at all times; and
- This position may also be required to serve as a laborer and perform general construction tasks, if needed.

Qualifications

Qualifications include:

- Valid Driver's License
- Some experience on construction sites preferred

Working Conditions

Although, operators will be in an enclosed cab, this position requires working outside where conditions may vary depending on the weather and may include extreme hot or cold outside temperatures, saturated grounds, rocky or hilly terrain and moderate precipitation.

Physical Requirements

This position involves sitting for extended periods of time, as well as the ability to climb up and down to enter and exit the truck.
